- 6) CHARLCOMBE LANE SUBSIDANCE AND LOW TRAFFIC NEIGHBOURHOODS
Cllr Chorley wanted to make Cllrs aware that he is looking in to turning Charlcombe Lane in to a Low Traffic Neighbourhood, and is in discussion with the Parish Council's Ward Councillors about this. The aim is to decrease the amount of traffic travelling along Charlcombe Lane and to halt further subsidence of the road. Cllr Chorley would like to have the support of Charlcombe Parish Council in pursuing this. Several Cllrs raised concerns that this would divert traffic to lanes in Woolley and Langridge, communities which would also benefit from being Low Traffic Neighbourhoods. They feel the Parish should benefit as a whole, not just the residents of Charlcombe. Cllr Chorley suggested they petition the Ward Councillors themselves or become champions for the Low Traffic Neighbourhoods in their areas, however as an individual Cllr Chorley is unable to petition for those areas himself as it is a time-consuming process. Cllr Jarai will email Cllrs a link to the B&NES Liveable Neighbourhood scheme which will enable them to flag sections of road which they believe would also benefit from the scheme.
