



Charlcombe Parish's beautiful footpaths are right on your doorstep!

Weston Short Route – A walk produced for Charlcombe Parish Council

A short circular walk to some worthwhile viewpoints.

This walk is just over **1 mile** and could take **30 to 40 minutes**.

It can be a little muddy in places at times.

DIRECTIONS

Start facing the noticeboard in front of the Moravian Church by the roundabout at the bottom of Lansdown Lane. Turn to your left and then right to follow the path up beside the church. Cross the road and continue to Weston recreation ground. Go straight across the recreation ground to find the gate leading to the Cotswold Way. Follow the Cotswold Way uphill and through the gate to the viewpoint at Penn Hill. Continue along the Costwold Way to the top of Dean Hill Lane (by Pendean Farm). From here you can continue just a few yards to get a view of Weston on your right. Return down Dean Hill Lane. About half way down Dean Hill Lane you can cross a stile on your right, then turn left across the field to another stile and straight across to a gate. Exit on to Westmead gardens and continue downhill to return to the Moravian Church.

ADDITIONAL NOTE – For greater views this walk can be extended to continue on the Cotswold Way from Pendean Farm to Kelston Round Hill (about an extra 1.5 miles; 45 minutes return) or to Prospect Stile (about an extra 2.5 miles; up to 90 minutes return).
